- The research that was conducted was about concussions in the game of hockey, and how the game is being changed to eliminate the likelihood of concussions. Some of the main points of research were on youth hockey, women's hockey vs. men's hockey, and also how the usage of equipment effects concussions and the changing rules of the NHL and concussion protocol. Concussion rates in men's hockey were 18.69 in every 1000 athletes, while rates in women's hockey were 12.1 in every 1000 athletes. On a Canadian Junior hockey team in a 52 game season 17 players were reported to have a total of 21 different concussions. 69% of these concussions were caused by hits to the head. One of the major focal points was that hitting in youth hockey needs to be reduced to all but none and that will be the best way to prevent a lot of concussions. The NHL is trying to remove fighting from the game because it is a big leader in the problem of concussions
